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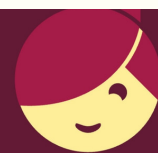
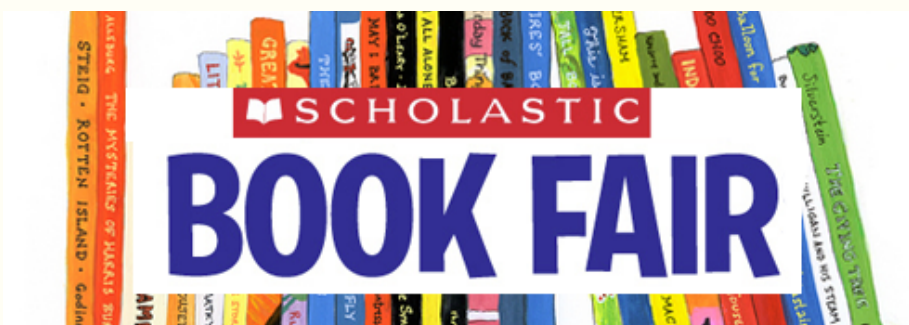
Exciting News!!

Using their student number, students can choose from thousands of books and audio books from the Davidson County Public Library circulation.

Students will need to download either the Overdrive App or the Libby App. I would highly recommend the Libby App, due to its ease and more user-friendly options. Both of these apps are available for Apple and Android devices.

NC KIDS DIGITAL LIBRARY STEPS

- Step 1:** Download Libby App to Device
Step 2: Go to: <https://nckids.overdrive.com/>
Step 3: "Click Sign In"
Step 4: Choose "Davidson County Public Library System" from the drop down menu
Step 5: Enter Card Number: This is the student's powerschool number or teacher's UID Number
Step 6: Enter Pin: Last 4 digits of Student's Powerschool Number or Teacher's UID Number
Step 7: Read! Read! Read!
