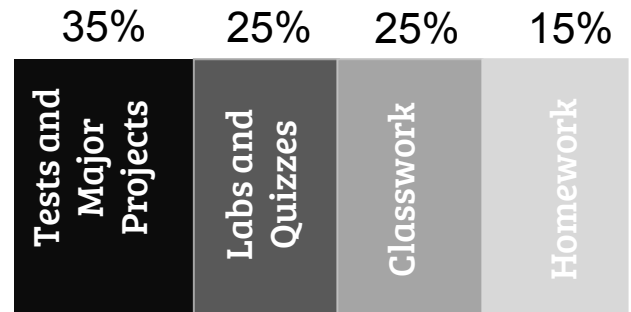
## CLASSROOM MATERIALS TO BE SUCCESSFUL

## ABSENCES AND GRADES

Please check Powerschool regularly and feel free to ask me any questions that you might have about your grades.

Late work will have 10% deducted per day up to five days. After the 5th day, the assignment will be given a zero and marked as missing. This includes work turned in with no name on it.

If you are absent, you are responsible for completing your make-up work. You have 5 days from the day you return to class to complete the work. After the 5th day, points will be deducted.

Printed make-up work will be placed in your classes absent folder and your name will be written on the work. Digital work can be found on Canvas. You are responsible for updating notes you missed. You can go online or you can borrow my notebook during homebase.

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## ELECTRONIC DEVICES
