

Care and Use of the Student iPad

- The Apple iPad that you will be issued is the property of the Lexington City School District and is made available to you as a tool for learning.
- The use of an iPad is a privilege that can be revoked (taken away). Inappropriate use or neglect of an iPad can result in limits to or loss of use of the iPad and additional consequences.
- You will only be permitted to use the iPad assigned to you. The iPad must be returned to the school in good working condition at the end of the school year or upon withdrawal or transfer.
- You will access only your assigned iPad at school each day as directed by your teacher. You are responsible for the care of this iPad throughout the whole time it is checked out of the cart.
- You must keep your assigned iPad at school and should not leave the iPad unattended outside of the classroom at any time.
- You may not mark the Apple iPad or case in any way with markers, stickers, etc. The district identification barcode sticker must not be removed.
- You must keep the iPad in the district-provided case at all times, and carry it carefully, with the case closed.
- iPads are to be kept on desks or other safe surfaces while in the classroom – never on the floor or in lockers.
- Do not eat or drink near the Apple iPad.
- You are only to be on the sites designated or assigned by your teacher.
- During PE class ALL students are required to place their iPads in a cart provided by the PE teacher.
