5 Quick Tips on How to Improve Your Child's Reading

The 5 to do's for every parent who wants to improve their child's reading are:

1. Make sure your child is reading at least 15 minutes every night. Increase the time over time. Make sure your child reads out loud so you can hear them speaking. Having your child to read aloud allows you to listen for understanding and pronunciation.
2. Make sure your child writes down any words they don't know how to pronounce. Also make sure your child writes down any word they do not know the meaning of.
3. Have your child look up all unknown words in the dictionary and write the definition and a sentence to help with use/understanding of the word.
4. Re-read with new understanding.
5. Write about the reading. The amount of writing will depend on the age(abilities)/ academic level of your child.
